AUDITOR'S REPORT

TO THE MEMBERS OF LORDS EDUCATION AND HEALTH SOCIETY

1. We have audited the accompanying financial statements of Lords Education and Health Society, as at March 31, 2014, and the related Income and Expenditure Account for the year then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.
2. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. 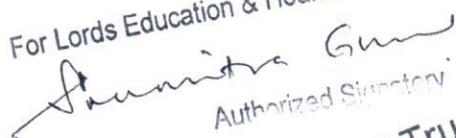

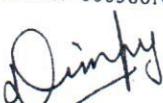

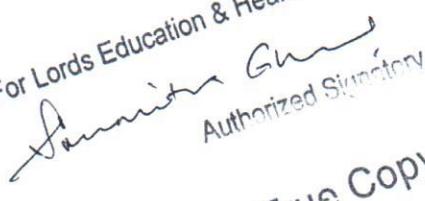

NOTE-13

1. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

A. Accounting Convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention on an accrual basis and in accordance with the mandatory accounting standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

B. Revenue Recognition

• Grants Received

Translation in foreign exchange in respect of Income and Expenditure items is recorded at the exchange rate at which the transaction is carried out.



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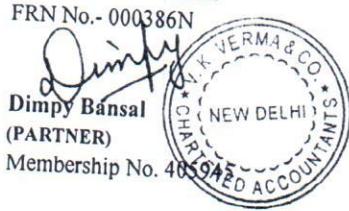
